All young people involved with this ministry are expected to:

- 1) Relate lovingly and Christ-like with all age groups.
- 2) Demonstrate a Christ-like wisdom beyond his/her years.
- 3) Demonstrate a deep understanding of Biblical "right" and "wrong."
- 4) Show signs of "Spiritual Fruit" based on his/her commitment to Christ.
- 5) Demonstrate a healthy, confident, Christ-based self-esteem.
- 6) Portray a humble and teachable spirit, showing room for growth.
- 7) Demonstrate a desire for "excellence" in each area of his/her life.
- 8) Stand out as a "role-model" among his/her peer group.
- 9) Behave in a manner that does not attract attention from the opposite sex.
- 10) Refrain from participating in "boyfriend"/"girlfriend" relationships.
- 11) Maintain a conservative, modest outward appearance.
- 12) Accept his/her God-given appearance and shows no desire to alter it.
- 13) Demonstrate a genuine respect towards all authority figures in his/her life.
- 14) Be described as compliant and not rebellious.
- 15) Communicate emotions, thoughts and needs effectively.
- 16) Demonstrate "good stewardship" of his/her spiritual and tangible gifts.
- 17) Display a "family oriented" lifestyle.
- 18) Initiate taking responsibility and meeting needs.
- 19) Demonstrate a mature understanding and application of Scripture.
- 20) Maintain a daily devotional and quiet time with God.
- 21) Maintain a Christ-centered focus; is not easily distracted or influenced.
- 22) Maintain a selfless, servant attitude; not self-centered.
- 23) Be described as "innocent" and "pure" in areas of his/her life.
- 24) Demonstrate desires, behaviors or beliefs that are not "worldly".
- 25) Be described as a "Prayer Warrior."
- 26) Maintain a wholesome and edifying speech.
- 27) Own an unwavering faith and healthy "fear of God."
- 28) Actively seek out counsel and accountability.
- 29) Demonstrate characteristics of a leader and not of a follower.
- 30) Identify, investigate, and improve weaknesses in his/her life.
- 31) Appear to act out of pure motives.
- 32) Demonstrate a well-rounded, well-balanced lifestyle.
- 33) Make himself/herself "available" to be used by God.
- 34) Demonstrate an acceptance and contentment to "trials" in his/her life.
- 35) Relate to and accept others who are not at the same level spiritually.
- 36) Handle and resolve conflict effectively and maturely.
- 37) Boldly and consistently share his/her Christian faith with others.
- 38) Be described as "self-disciplined" and "self-motivated."
- 39) Demonstrate integrity when it appears that no one else is looking.
